









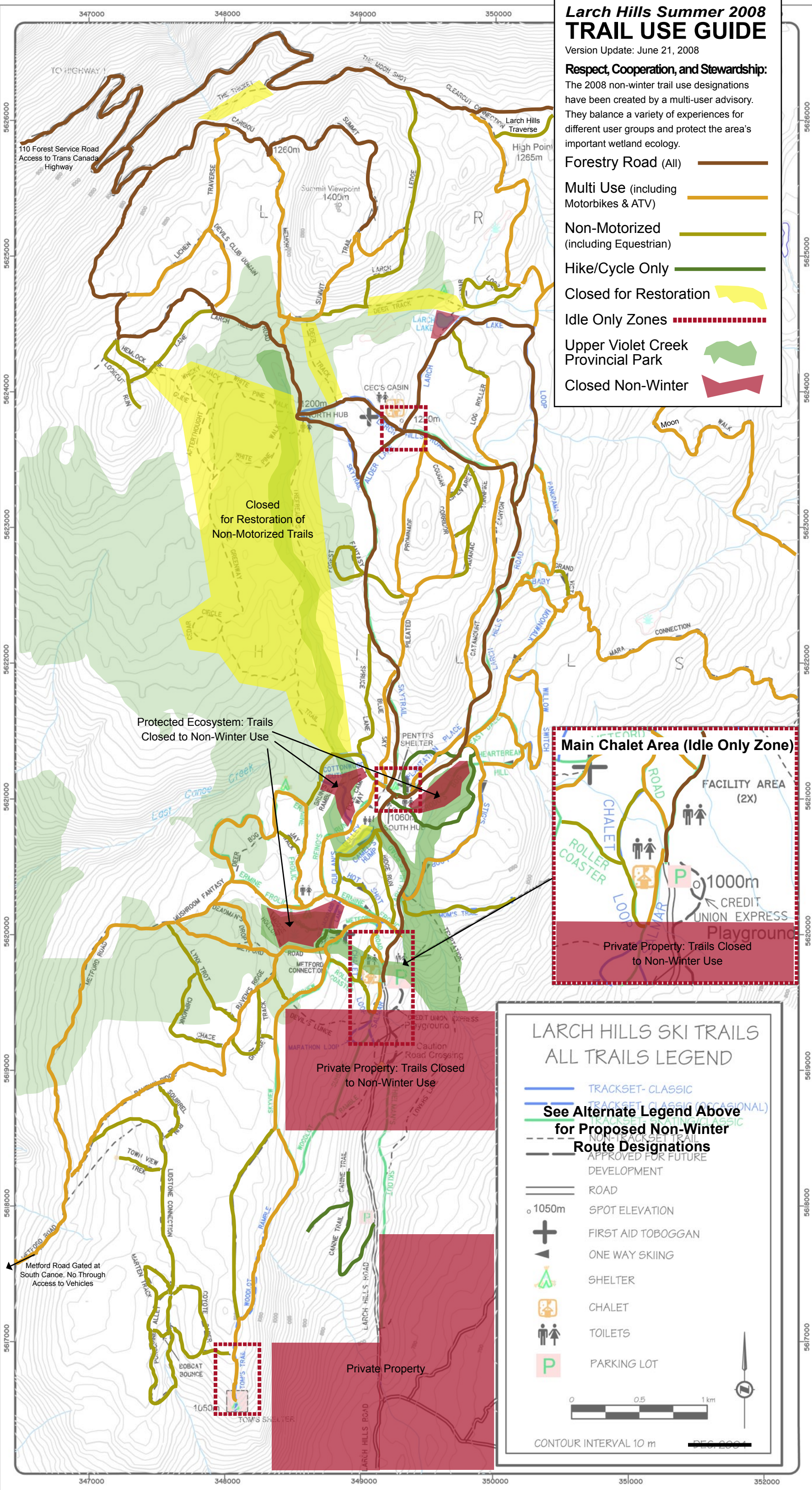
Larch Hills Summer 2008 TRAIL USE GUIDE
