CSRD – grant application going in for windows and doors. Randi Ostby is sending in grant application for the Southern Interior Development Trust. Application is for \$25000.00. BC gaming special intake grant for capital – can ask for up to \$250000.00 –an application will be submitted requesting \$100000.00. Application submitted to Shuswap Community Foundation – requested \$10000.00. Current payments include: \$18000.00 to contractor for foundation, \$7000 for boiler; expecting bill for framing and subfloor. Current available funds will be depleted by late fall. Will do another fundraising drive in the fall with memberships – need to get another e-note out to members.
