Current construction payments status: half of the log order has been paid for. Will be receiving a few more bills soon; from Trevor Harrison, boiler, & insulated pipe.

Chris Elliott — construction update: pipe is being laid to boiler; John Theilman will then backfill; Al Hardy will figure the in-floor heating layout and design. Boiler will heat chalet, track setter

shed and Pauline Hixon's. After floor system is complete, posts will be installed then deck. Lots of design work going on. Canoe will give plywood at cost and T & G flooring at cost. Biggest challenge will be man power.

Q & A session. Received 3 cheques so far from CCC. About \$10500.00 received since March and have not received a cheque from CCC yet for this. Dances with the stars scheduled for the fall again.
