Committee Reports:

Membership: Written report by M. Reagan attached.

Track setter update: Steve Rafel – machine is having a hard time with the current hard snow conditions. Looking for feedback on condition of groomed trails. Steve contacted Snow Valley for information regarding their similar machine. Recommended heavier duty sprockets (magnum?). We can currently replace the rubber sprockets under warranty but will look at the cost to upgrading to the magnum sprockets.

Trails: Blaine Carson; asked if far-east trails are being utilized. Members mentioned it would be nice to make a loop back to baby moonwalk. Discussion about south canoe and far north – Blaine will bring these up at the joint trail committee meeting this month.

Snowshoe trails: Clint Smith; signage mostly complete. New maps now available.

Safety Committee update: Jim Ellis. Had 7 people take course on hooking up toboggans to snowmobile. Currently reviewing first aid courses and costs. Will be making recommendations at next safety committee meeting. Chainsaw safety courses – looking at bringing in an instructor at a cost of \$1500 for 10 people. Accident report forms are in all the first aid kits. Filled out forms can be placed in donation box. Communication – have some donated radios from Terratek but still have dead spots. Alternatively, can rent radios from Vella radio – they have repeaters in the area so the coverage is better. Blaine suggests we need 4 radios. Blaine will review and provide information back to the executive.

Ski Patrol: Steve Raffel – the 2 trained individuals are covered under the Canadian ski patrol liability. Provided information on heating blankets – would like to see the club invest in a couple of blankets.

Programs: Megan Brooke & Carmen Fennell – **Jackrabbit and skills development program**. No report. – **Junior race team.** Abbi – 4 skiers
qualified to go to BC winter games. Reviewed races to date. **Schools Ski Hosts** – Duncan reported that the program went well.

Events:

Lantern Ski: - very well attended. Suggestion made to look at ways to include snow shoe participants. Donation was made to second harvest of \$405.17
