#### Minutes:

Minutes of the October 10, 2017 GM were not read and are available on the website. Debbie Phillips moved to accept the minutes. Seconded by Kerri Wilkinson. Carried.

Business Arising: Brad Calkins will be chief of race for loppet; Jim Beckner chief steward

New business: none

Treasurer's Report: Allan Bahen – read and reviewed report - attached. Insurance expenses – increased coverage by \$400,000. Steve Fabro facilitated a modest cost increase of \$400.

Chalet Expansion Committee Update & Fundraising: Suzy Beckner – Applied for \$25,000 from SASCU for specific items and provided quotes. About \$15,000 in donations currently at Cross Country Canada. Building – shingles on, roof for stadium side will be done in the spring. Basement wiring is done. Insulation and vapour barrier to go in next week; drywall in January. Cubbies for basement have been built and will be installed once drywall is in. Profits from Dances with Stars (DWS) were about \$37,000. Plans are underway to do DWS again next year and splitting profits with hospice. Proposed date is Nov 23, 2018.

#### Youth Programs Reports:

Junior Ski Team – Abbi May – 110 kids. Training up at Larch Hills now, Ski team held a snow camp up at Silver Star at the beginning of December – almost all kids participated. 30 athletes participated in Vernon NorAm races; about 20 going to Rossland. Ok Cup race at Larch Hills on December 30<sup>th</sup>; Natalie Wilkie attended the Para Nordic training camp and World Cup Para Nordic races in Canmore – placed 4<sup>th</sup> in all her events and qualified for Paralympics. Natalie and Abbi received FACE grant from petro Canada to help with training and competition costs.

# General Meeting December 12, 2017

### Tracksetter Report

We started grooming the trails with snowmobiles and stairs on November 5 which was about a month and one half earlier than last season. After a week or so of packing snow the snow disappeared after a warm spell melting most of the ski area. We resumed packing later in November and Ginzug grooming and track setting on Dec 2. We have yet to use the Pisten Bulley due to an insufficient amount of snow. Using the PB with only 10cm of snow would result in bringing up dirt and debris. Mixed with the snow it would be a problem well into the season. I would like to acknowledge the hard work by John Thielman, Phil Wallensteen and Jim Nadler and the extra gang for preparing the ski trails. I can take questions before submitting this report.

# Safety Report

No incident reported to date and we are in the process of putting up our chloroplast "You are here" signs. We will continue with the Safety Host program like last year. We are training or recertifying 9 safety hosts in OFA-1. On Jan. 11 we have 6 scheduled to take the TEC-1(Safe moving of injured). We have 17 safety hosts in total. We have tentatively scheduled a mock rescue with Salmon Arm Search and Rescue for Feb. 14, 2018 at 18:45.

A reminder to skiers to check the Safety Hosts Sign Out Board next to Chalet's main door. We suggest taking a photo of the board on your smart phone or make a note before heading out on skiing.

I am tracking safety related incidents so would appreciate contact from someone if that is the case. We are required to notify authorities as part of our management agreement. The purpose is also to review any safety incidents so we can possibly prevent similar cases. I can take questions before submitting this report.

#### Lantern Ski

Preparation for the Lantern Ski on Dec. 28 are coming along well. The lanterns are ready to go thanks to our servicing crew Rick Hirtle, Jeannetta and George Zorn, Keith Cox, Jim Nadler and a special thank you to Roland Huster for helping and letting us park the lantern trailer on his property and the use of his work shop. I am very grateful to Jim and Marcia Beckner for coordinating the lamp lighter volunteers even though they cannot be here for the event. Pauline Waelti and Peter Molnar will coordinate on the day

so thanks to them as well. I hope to have at least two people at the welcome and sign in desk throughout the evening for short ½ hr. stints. I need about 12 people to make sure guests sign in, explain the routes based on their abilities. Let me know if you can help. I can take questions before submitting this report.
