General Meeting December 10, 2019 7:00 PM Minutes

Welcome/Introductions

- Quorum: # of members in attendance 28. Ed Bouma -President, Don Miller -Treasurer. Laura Hepburn -Secretary
- Agenda motion to accept Pauline Hickson. Clint Smith 2nd
- Minutes of October 8, 2019 General Meeting Craig McBride motion to approve. Kerry Orchard 2nd all in favour.

New Business:

- Treasurer Report- Don Miller- Arwen's dream cost \$12,000. (Tolko -Log Contractor's Hauling association has donated \$3500 for the beginner trail- as in minutes of from executive meeting October 2018)
 - George pointed out that some of the cost included his work on other trails and maintenance. \$108,000 is held in the tracksetter replacement fund. \$82,000 received for registration so far this year. See attached report from Don.
- **Chalet Expansion** Suzy Beckner. The project is essentially complete. The handicapped washroom just needs the toilet and sink installed. No further expenditures are anticipated.
- Land Use & Trail Planning Committee Update Craig McBride

Summer use trails- Trail Alliance and Rec Sites and Trails have formed a partnership to manage summer use trails in Larch Hills. A trail advisory committee has been formed including representatives from motorized, equestrian and LHNS.

Fire proofing was done this summer.

High branch pruning has been completed.

Private property update- There was garbage dumped on the private property through the summer so the owner installed a new gate. The area remains open for winter use by LHNS skiers.

Tom's Shelter- Clint Smith- No Maintenance has been done to the shelter and he has some concerns about the structural integrity and safety. Duncan Morris will be inspecting it.

- Rentals Caretaker Pauline Hickson/Executive assistant Karen Tanchak
- Karen welcomes members to come to the office to meet her. She and Ed are doing the trail reports now and she will be taking over. Please report trail conditions to her.
- Winter chalet rentals will be done by Karen, and in summer by Pauline.
- Youth Program Reports:

Junior Ski Team -Abbi May head coach. There are 105 kids on the race team this year. The Annual silver star camp held in mid November went very well. We have had 2 races so far this season -Sovereign Lake Open – 35 racers from LH competed. Noram races in Canmore this past weekend was attended by a group of older skiers.

Ski exchange - A large group of thirteen and fourteen year old skiers came from Nakkerotok for the past week for an exchange experience. A group of Larch Hills skiers will be going to Ottawa later this winter.

Jackrabbits- Luke Heckrodt was not in attendance to report. 115 are registered.

Committee Reports:

Membership Update - Marcia Beckner for Jan Naylor

981 members have registered this season so far. There were 1100 total last year. More women than men have registered. 104 Jr racers, 4 explores, 115 jackrabbits.

Jan would like to add a motion to add a single parent category for \$120 rather than the \$240 fee for two parent families. The family membership is equal to the cost of two adult passes with the children being free so she argued that a single parent should also have their children ski without extra cost. Ed said this will be put in enote and also discussed at the next executive meeting prior to a vote at the next general meeting.

Lighting Committee – Rob van Varseveld - Randi Ostby has made packages for fundraising and Duncan has organized tax deductible donations through Nordiq Canada. \$67,000 has been raised to date. They are also working on approval to proceed and hope to have it by spring. The committee has researched solar lighting but have opted for LED system with underground wiring. Solar is more expensive initially. Electricity cost is predicted to be about \$1000/yr.

Tracksetting: Ed Bouma's report:

The tracksetting crew has been out daily packing snow and when conditions warranted, they set a single track with the ginzu groomer. We have had as many as 18 different volunteer groomers out since we had enough snow to work it. The Kubota is working out well and complements the snowmobiles when it comes to packing the trails. The new drags designed and built by Jim Nadler are superb and much better in early season grooming. Unfortunately, our newest Scandic 2015 is in for repair as the engine overheated due to an undetectable coolant leak. We are waiting for an estimate. The PB Edge has not yet been used.

Facilities (Cec's, other) Update – Ed Bouma's report:

We still need to do an assessment of the Tom Jordan shelter and we hope there is someone in our organization who can do that for us to make sure it is structurally sound. So far the other buildings are in reasonable shape. Cec's has wood and still needs a good clean and the fire extinguisher. The pots and pans we had there last year have gone walkabout. Please forward any concerns to me.

Safety Committee. Safety Committee: Ed Bouma's report:

I attended one too many meetings and am now the safety committee chair again. We had a meeting yesterday to finalize plans for instituting a single emergency number in case of emergency. We will also pre-position the sleds and safety equipment when we can and conditions permit probably next week. We are planning a safety host get together on Dec. 20 and an open to all safety seminar on January 11 with one presentation from 10 to 11:30 and another from 12:45 to 2:15pm. They are looking for more safety hosts.

Trails Update – Craig McBride – Send an email to Karen if any concerns on the trails. Clint Smith has been looking after trees down on the snowshoe trails.

Allan Bahen – discussed tree removal from trails last summer on LH road and Baby Moon Walk and East Dales and lower Panorama. These costs were added to Arwen's Dream. The stumpage cost was very high. In future Alan thinks it would be worth trying to get a salvage licence to reduce costs. He thanked George Jackson and John Thielman for their extensive work on this project.

Trail Host Update- John Henderson- He would like to have coverage through most of the holiday season. More volunteers are needed. Suzy will organize an enote to request volunteers. John suggested they should be called Trail Greeters as the hosts work from outside the Chalet.

Naming Buildings Policy – Open discussion

The chalet committee recommended naming the Chalet the Rob Nash Memorial Chalet. The executive supported this at the November meeting but there has been some further discussion about club policy around naming trails and buildings after members. Discussion ensued. Another suggestion was to call it the Larch Hills Memorial Chalet and have a plaque inside explaining Rob's involvement along with memorial plaques for other important Larch Hills volunteers. Don moved to table the issue for the next general meeting. Pauline 2nd. All in favour. An enote will be sent to invite members to come to the meeting to participate in the discussion and vote.
