- 2. **Adopt Agenda** Brad motioned to adopt, Clint 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 3. **Minutes of last meeting** Dec. 3, 2019. Don motioned to accept, Abbi 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favour.
- 4. **Business arising**. We are not a member of sport BC so kidsport will no longer sponsor LH members. Karen continues to look for other avenues.
- 5. **Treasurer Report** Don Miller- see attached report. Don will report donations to Karen and she will look after thank you cards or certificates. Don is working on the annual financial statements. We will continue to use Trent Sismey Inc. We will continue to get a review engagement of the annual statement by the accountant as this is important for grant applications.
- 6. Tree Blowdown and affect on RKS.

The plan is to clear all the trees from the route prior to the loppet. Crews continue to clear trees daily. Trails below the South hub were cleared but trees continue to come down. The recreational 30km route will also be cleared if possible.

- 7. **Tom's Shelter**-Clint continues to work on having the structure inspected. **Penti's shelter** may not be safe with heavy snow on the roof. We will put a do not enter sign on it until it can be shovelled.
- 8. **Lighting Committee** Craig. Fundraising continues. The application is pending with Rec sites and trails.
- 9. **Tracksetter update** -Ed. They are looking for a snowmobile replacement. The PB has also had some difficulties. The oilpan

needs to be replaced and this can't be done until later this week. It is still in use. There are ongoing problems with the cooling fan as well. Now the universal joint from the tiller is broken but it should be fixed by tomorrow. The PB is required to help with clearing the trees.

The kubota is working very well and we will consider getting a second one in future.

10. **Club Manager report**-Karen- see attached report.

### Additions:

- 1. **Naming of the Chalet**. Karen has not found a policy yet about naming of trails in previous minutes. The executive will present a motion at the next general meeting to name the chalet the Rob Nash Memorial Chalet.
- 2. **Snowshoe update**. People on snowshoes can't get up beside the stairs right now. We will ask George to push snow to make a better ramp and prevent cars parking in front of the it. There are two signs with different costs of snowshoeing. The actual cost is \$8 for adults and \$5 for youth.
- 3. **Sledding** There was discussion about if we should have a designated sledding trail. Sledding on the Beast is not safe and we will put a no sledding sign there.
- 4. **Hillbilly flats** There is a cutoff trail on Arwin's Dream which is an old skidder trail. It is a steep hill to the left. The trail planning committee will assess this section of trail.
- 5. **Single parent memberships**. We discussed options for a discount for membership of one parent families as suggested by Jan Naylor. Brad will research what other clubs have done and present at the next meeting.
- 6. **Back-up power for the chalet** should be available to prevent lines freezing when the power goes out. Ed suggested a generator plug in at the boiler for heat, then the pumps will run. We will need to lock the bathrooms or keep the pump working in that situation. Ed is going to look into this with BC hydro.
- 7. **Dog trail shovels**. There are no shovels hanging. Ed will check with Allan.
