6. Land Use and Trail Planning Committee Report – David Still waiting for feedback from the First Nations on the Link Trail. No section 57 has been submitted at this point. Craig is trying to get diverse bands to coordinate with the Splatsin as they were the lead on both the Arwen's Dream and the Lighting projects. We are considering going ahead on the section 57 application with a note explaining that we are waiting for consultation with 1<sup>st</sup> Nations. This would at least get the file started.

#### Dog trail –

Craig M, Phil W, George J and Keith C walked and flagged it. They came up with timber values (currently on the decline) and construction costs. These were then passed on to the owner for feedback. The owner wants full PB width rather than Ginzu width to maximize the amount of timber harvested. That does not mean we are obliged to Groom to full width.

That contract was approx. six weeks ago, roughly two weeks ago we were told that he was very busy and had not had time to properly look at it

Our opinion is that there is less than a 50% chance of anything further happening for this season.

We will discuss a trial run for a South loop/one way dog trail for the 2022/23 season next meeting.

### Small Equipment Committee:

7 loads of gravel were delivered to the Bunker/Equipment yard on June 23. George spread and packed the Gravel a week or so later. Baird Bros was the vendor.

Thanks to Robert for the contact info and George for the machine work.

David consulted with Chuck Wilson concerning pre-season service and repairs. He has been made aware of what needs to be done in order to start the season in good shape. The 2009 has starter issues and both need the clutches checked and the Kubota was a broken door handle, hand brake and possibly rodent related wiring issues. The flat tire has been repaired and picked up from Del-tec.

The committee has worked out an ongoing in season maintenance schedule similar to the PB however it would be monthly rather than weekly and does not need to be nearly as intense.
